

The Lord be with you: And also with you

Luke 24:44-53

Then Jesus said to them, 'These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you—that everything written about me in the law of Moses, the prophets, and the psalms must be fulfilled.' Then he opened their minds to understand the scriptures, and he said to them, 'Thus it is written, that the Messiah is to suffer and to rise from the dead on the third day, and that repentance and forgiveness of sins is to be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things. And see, I am sending upon you what my Father promised; so stay here in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high.'

The Ascension of Jesus

Then Jesus led them out as far as Bethany, and, lifting up his hands, he blessed them. While he was blessing them, he withdrew from them and was carried up into heaven. And they worshipped him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy.

Reflection

When Jesus ascended to become physically part of the Trinity of God again, the world didn't end, heavens gates didn't close, all was not lost. Rather we see worship, joy and new purpose in the disciples.

We see that those left behind are far from abandoned, in 9 days (7 now!) following ascension God sends another part of God, the Holy Spirit, to be with them, to be with us always. To minister to us, to guide us, to prepare us for our role as Christ's hands and heart here on earth.

We are left with reassurance, we are left with purpose.

What we do matters to God, not in a watching, waiting to punish us kind of way, but in a loving, encouraging, supportive parent type of way, whose heart grows when they see our hearts grow for care of ourselves, others and the world.

Can our purpose be accomplished from the confines of a home? Absolutely – because that smile, that call, that word of encouragement, that prayer, that food cooked to nourish, that support of a good cause, that opening of our heart to God's presence, that breath in the sunlight matters. So breathe, pray and smile, all is never lost. Amen
